Looking for a little extra help in your department this summer? In collaboration with the Private Industry Council (PIC) and Brighton High School, we have several high school students who will be prepped, trained and ready to work as summer interns! The program runs for seven weeks from the beginning of July through the end of August. Students generally work between 25 and 40 hours per week, depending on the amount of work available and the student's availability.

Providing a mentoring experience for an engaging young adult is a rewarding experience. Every summer job provides an opportunity to learn workplace skills such as communication, teamwork and time management. Supervisors are given training and on-going support by PIC and Human Resources to help facilitate the working experience for both the student and the department.

The "PIC Works" program is funded by a private grant and is at **no cost** to participating departments. This grant was created to promote minority students in getting access and exposure to exciting careers in health care! Human Resources will be working closely with departments to identify students that will best meet your needs.
