Summer 2008 Results

79 students at 3 employer sites participated in Classroom at the Workplace: SAT Prep for 6 weeks during the summer

Students received **27 hours of SAT prep** in classes of a maximum of 8 students over the summer

103 point average increase from pre-SAT test to post-SAT test cumulatively

Math: 40 point average score increase

Critical Reading: 39 point average score increase

Writing: 24 point average score increase

Students demonstrate **increased confidence** and **insight** into the connections between academic and career success.
