PIC career specialists focus on job readiness training with high school students throughout the year. Mock interviews offer students the opportunity to practice interviewing and sharpen their interpersonal skills.

During the week of April school vacation, the PIC hosts eight half- day Mock Interview sessions. Employers and community volunteers serve as the interviewers and evaluate students on the following skills:

- Verbal communication
- Non-verbal communication
- Appearance
- Attitude
- Maturity

A student who makes a favorable impression during an interview has a better chance of winning a job. With a more competitive labor market for teenagers, it is critical that students learn to hone this skill.
