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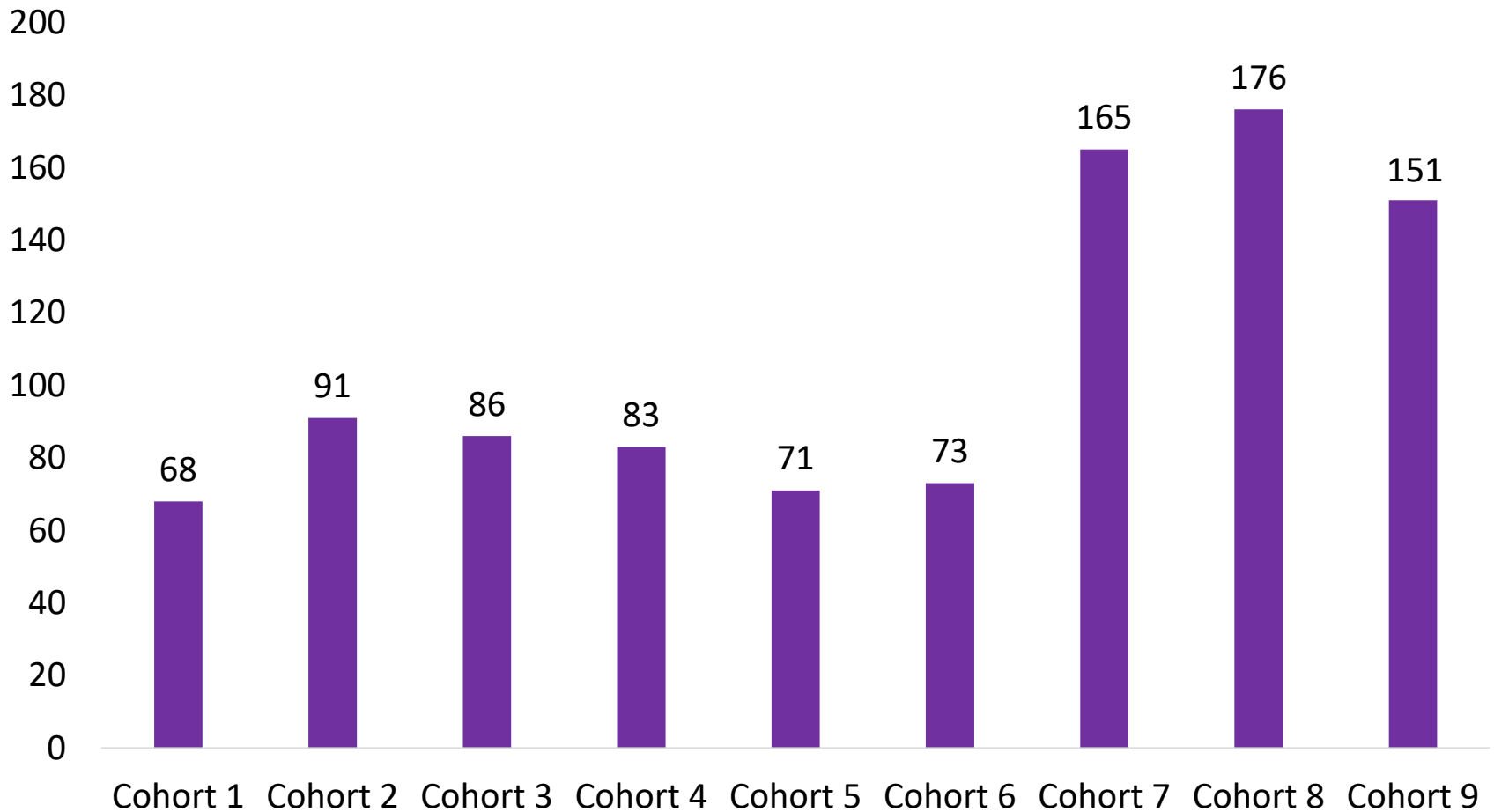
Boston PIC Postsecondary Coaching

Students per cohort, BPS Class of 2009 (Cohort 1) to BPS Class of 2017 (Cohort 9)

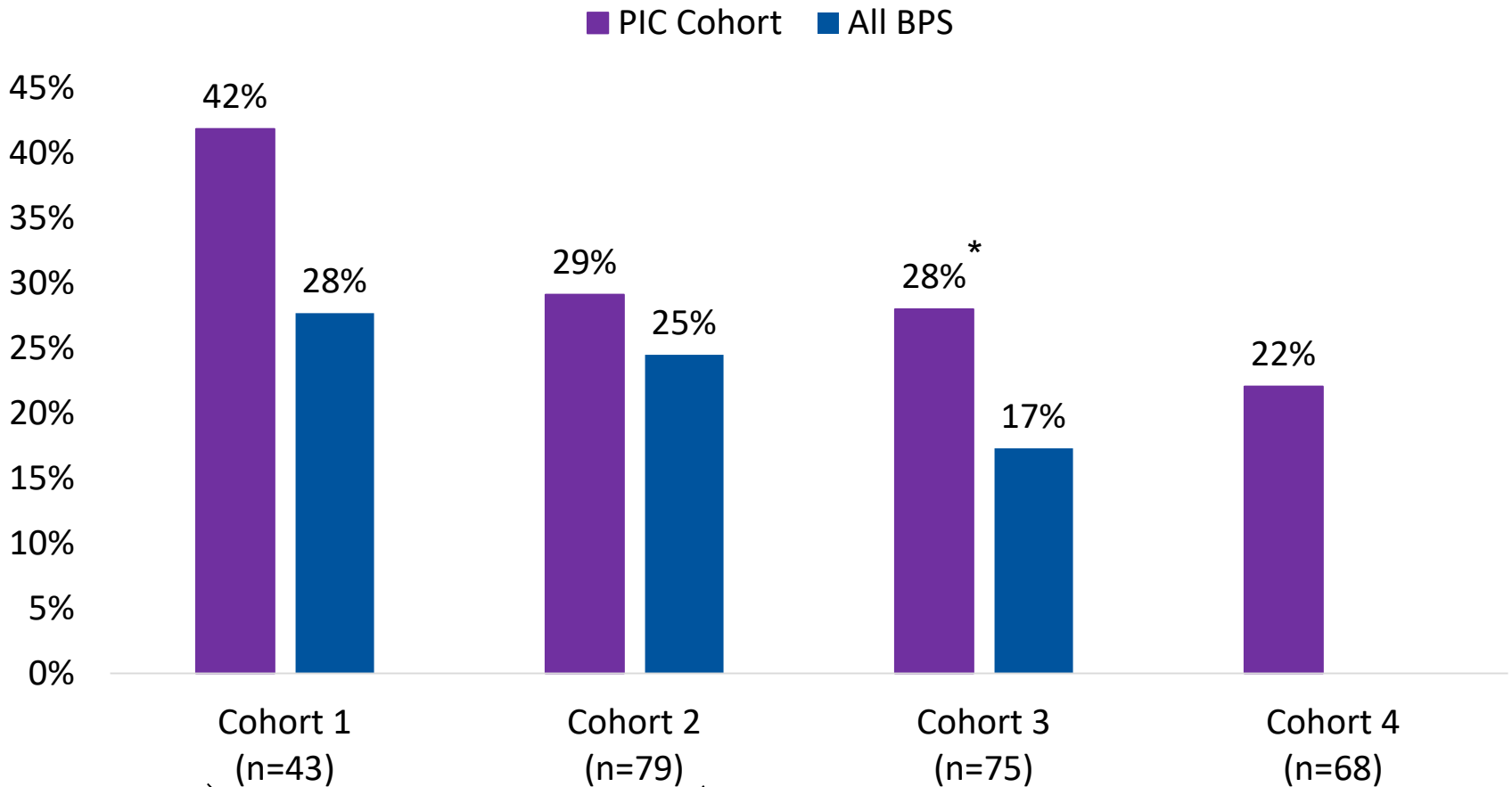

PIC Graduation Rate Compared to Non-Coached Students

- ▶ The six-year graduation rate of the first cohort of PIC Success Boston students, from the BPS Class of 2009, starting at a two-year public college the year after high school is **36.8%**, compared to the **23.8%** graduation rate for non-Success Boston BPS Class of 2009 students who started at a two-year public college the year after high school.
